The Service Project Cycle incorporates three key elements:

- 1) Funding and Sponsorship.
- 2) Carrying out the Service Project.
- 3) Celebrating the Work!

The Aim of the Service Project Cycle is to assist Rovers to structure a Service Project aligning itself with the Plan/Do/Review ethos of the One Programme.

RAW:

Rover Action Week (RAW) is a week that you can set yourself to carry out the main body of work for your service projects or just use it as an opportunity to boost the awareness of an ongoing project. It takes place during Easter week so you have time to really get stuck into your project!

In order to help aid your projects we have a fund to help you alongside your other fundraising.
