What is JOTI?

Jamboree on the Internet (JOTI) is part of the world's largest digital Scout event, connecting millions of Scouts around the globe using the internet. It's a safe space to make friends, learn about other cultures, and participate in fun online activities.

Step-by-Step: How to Access the JOTI Platform

1. Check Your Setup

Before you get started, make sure you have:

- A computer, tablet, or smartphone with internet access
- A modern web browser (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Edge)
- Your Scout's (if under age 13, parental permission may be required)

2. Go to the Official JOTI Platform

- Open your browser and visit: <https://www.jotajoti.info>

This is the central hub for all JOTA-JOTI activities.

3. Register or Log In

- Some areas of the site may be open without logging in, but full access requires a profile.
- Click on "Join JOTA-JOTI" or "Log In"
- You may need to:
 - Create a WOSM profile
 - Enter your Scouting details (country, group, age)
 - Agree to the safe online behaviour guidelines



4. Stay Safe Online

Before using any chat features:

- Read the Safe JOTA-JOTI Pledge ([here](#))
- Follow the Safe from Harm guidance
- Use your first name only, and never share personal info

What Can You Do on JOTI?

Once logged in, explore:

- JOTI Chat – Talk with Scouts from around the world
- JamPuz – Exchange special codes with others to collect puzzle pieces
- International Campfire – Join global live streams, games, and performances
- Learning Lab – Participate in interactive workshops
- Games & Challenges – Take part in fun Scout-themed activities
- Live Shows – Watch international panels, stories, and entertainment

Bonus: Prepare Before the Weekend

- Talk to your Scout leader and plan your participation
- Test your device and internet connection
- Check the JOTI schedule online for your time zone
- Have your Scout scarf or uniform ready – we're representing Scouting Ireland!
